#### 2022-23 school year: Families must apply to receive free meals!

For the upcoming 2022-23 school year, students will no longer receive free meals unless they have been approved for the Free and Reduced Meals program. This is a change from this year (the 2021-22 school year) with free meals being offered to all PSD students. The program that helped make that possible (related to the pandemic) is ending. For the 2022-23 school year, families must apply and be approved for the Free and Reduced Meals program to receive benefits. Applications for the 2022-23 school year are now being accepted. ## **Classroom Treats**

If it is necessary to have food in classrooms during school hours (i.e. birthday snack, holidays, special occasions, school events, etc.), only commercially prepared foods and packaged foods from retail stores should be served. Items must be commercially individually wrapped. As always, please contact your child's teacher prior to sending food or treats in.

## News from the School Counselor:

Our School Counselor will begin teaching the Second Step Curriculum this week. Second Step Elementary is designed to help kids succeed in school and in life by teaching them skills for learning- such as focusing attention and listening- as well as how to manage their emotions, solve problems, and make friends. We will periodically send Home Links to parents throughout the year. The Home Links will be sent home so that parents know what we are teaching and how they can best support our efforts. There is a spot for parents to sign at the bottom, but we will not be collecting these papers, so there is no need to sign or return them. The Home Links are optional however we encourage families to reinforce these skills at home. If you have any

- 4. Verify your account via email.
- 5. Go through the prompts to create a caregiver account.
- 6. Login and click "Family Access".
- 7. Enter the following activation key in the "Family Access" section for the appropriate grade level:
  - 1. Kindergarten and Grade 1: SSP1 FAMI LY71
  - 2. Grade 2: SSP2 FAMI LY72
  - 3. Grade 3: SSP3 FAMI LY73
  - 4. Grade 4: SSP4 FAMI LY74
  - 5. Grade 5: SSP5 FAMI LY75

#### News from our Health Office:

Students are **not to carry cough drops** in their back packs for use during the school day. If cough drops are required, there is a Medication Authorization form from the Health Room that must be completed for any medication to be given at school (prescription or over the counter). This form needs to be filled out and signed by the Health Care Provider and then signed by the Parent and returned to the health room with the cough drops in their original package. Once this process is complete, the student can come to the Health Room and the Health Room Tech will give them a cough drop. Mints/candies are an alternative for dry throats that can be carried by the student so they can use as they need

Vaccination Exclusion Day is Nov. 1, 2022. Your student may be excluded from school if the school does not have an up-to-date vaccine record, certificate of exemption, or in-process plan on file for your student.

Your student must be vaccinated against:

- Hepatitis B (HepB)
- Diptheria, tetanus, pertussis (DTaP, DTP, Tdap)
- Polio (IPV)
- Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR)
- Varicella (chicken pox)

Please be advised when your student returns to school from an illness and had any of the following symptoms:

- fever or chills
- cough,
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- fatigue, muscle, or body aches
- headache
- new loss of taste or smell
- sore throat
- congestion or runny nose
- nausea or vomiting, diarrhea

a NEGATIVE Covid test is required (home test is accepted).

**Except**, if someone in the household had COVID-19 in the previous 10 days, a negative PCR or molecular test is required.
