Start Times

The following are important times to note...

7:40am Cafeteria opens for Breakfast (Please do not send students to school prior to 7:40am)

7:45am Supervision on Campus Starts (If student is not eating breakfast, this is when drop off begins)

8:00am Classroom Doors Open

8:05am Official Start Time, Learning for the Day Officially Begins

*If you arrive after 8:05am, please come to the front office entry to drop off your student.

Morning Drop Off

If you are walking or biking please use the walking paths around campus and if biking, please dismount when coming on campus. We have lots of staff on duty, so please let us know if you need anything.

When dropping off/picking up via car, you have two options (please note the procedures are a little different per zone):

Southside (Stuart St.) Kiss-n-Go Procedures 2022-2023

- Park behind (East of) the bus zone marked by the Kid Loading Zone Signs and or cones, PLEASE STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE
- 2. Park behind the next car facing west, **do not pull in front of other cars**; this line will move forward when students begin unloading in the AM and loading into cars in the PM.
- 3. As the line moves forward westbound, staff will help guide your student safely, **from** in the AM and **to** in the PM your car. Your child may get in and out of your vehicle independently and use the sidewalk to enter campus at the open gate. **You no longer need to wait for an attendant to open your door.**

4. When your student is loaded, you may progress into west-moving traffic on Stuart. There are **no U-turns**. If you need to head eastbound on Stuart, take a left on Welch and continue around the block to access Stuart East Bound Traffic.

If this procedure does not work for your family, please park either on the Southside of Stuart Street and use crosswalks to come onto campus to meet your student, or park on Stuart, east of the Brookwood intersection.

OR

Westside (Front of School) Kiss-n-Go Procedures 2022-2023

- 1. Pull into the dedicated Drop off lane in the front of the school and PLEASE STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE during all drop off.
- 2. Pull up until you round the side of the school and see the cones and staff. **Do not pull in front of other cars**; this line will move forward when students begin unloading in the AM and loading into cars in the PM.
- 3. As the line moves forward northbound, staff will come to your car, open the door, help with car seats and seatbelts, and help gather all the belongings. Please do not get out of your car.
- 4. During pick up at the end of the day, we also need your help and support. Please stay in order in line and join the back of the line when you arrive. Stay in your car and we will bring your child(ren) to your car. It really helps when you put your last name on a sign on the dash so we can call your student quickly.

If we all do our part, we will maintain a safe and efficient process. From dismissal time to when every student has been put in a car is under 10 minutes if you use our pick-up lanes! This is phenomenal work on the part of our families and staff. Please contact the main office if you need help figuring out a plan that works for you and your child. We are here to help!

Change in Dismissal Plans:

In the morning, please make sure to review with your child where to go at dismissal if it changes by day. Also, make sure your child's teacher knows and has the plan for each day. We know that sometimes changes happen. Please call the front office if there is a change during

the school day and you need to communicate it to your child. Our teachers aren't always able to check email or voicemail during the day and so communicating it to the office assures that your child gets the message. We ask that you do this <u>before 1pm</u> as the end of the day gets busy in the office.

News from Child Nutrition:

2022-23 school year: Families must apply to receive free meals!

For the upcoming 2022-23 school year, students will no longer receive free meals unless they have been approved for the Free and Reduced Meals program. This is a change from this year (the 2021-22 school year) with free meals being offered to all PSD students. The program that helped make that possible (related to the pandemic) is ending. For the 2022-23 school year, families must apply and be approved for the Free and Reduced Meals program to receive benefits. Applications for the 2022-23 school year are now being accepted.
