Fourth and Fifth Grade families,

Riffenburgh will be having a Science Fair and fourth and fifth grade students are welcome to participate. The fair will take place on April 28th.

And there are two ways to participate. Your student can work at home on their science fair project. They will be given instructions on what is needed, but otherwise it is a project to be completed at home. If they choose to do this on their own, they can request information from their classroom teacher or Mr. Seeber. They will receive a packet on how to plan out their project. Please let either your teacher or Mr. Seeber know by April 7.

Or, this year, they can join the Science Fair Club! We will meet Wednesday mornings from 7:15am to 7:45am starting March 29th. Students will get support and advice as well as work with students in developing their project. They still will need to complete the experiments, journals, and display creation at home, but they will be guided by teachers through their process.
